Auction Information and Catalogue of Lots

General Auction Information

The auction will be held during the evening of 4th February and will be split into two sections:

- A silent auction
 - Where quiz attendees will be able to silently bid on the auction lots throughout the evening by filling in a form
- A live auction
 - Run by an auctioneer
 - Where quiz attendees will be able to raise a hand to bid on an auction lot

The remainder of this booklet contains information on how both elements of the auction will work, and details of the lots that are available to bid on for both auctions as well as what you'll need to do if you're not attending on the night but would like to bid on an item in either auction

Silent Auction Information

How it works on the night

- 1. Choose the item you want to bid for
- 2. Find the correct auction form in the room
- 3. Write your name, table number and bid amount into the form
- 4. Check back throughout the evening and bid again if someone has bid more than you
- 5. When the silent auction closes a member from the auction team will come and take your payment at the table (Cash, Cheque or Card) if you've won we'll also ask for your contact details
- 6. Once you've paid, you'll receive your auction item, or details of how to access your auction item to take away with you

I want to bid on an item but am not coming to the quiz...

If there's a silent auction item you'd like to bid for but you won't be attending on the night please ask a choir friend who is planning on attending to act as a proxy for you. They will need the following:

- 1. Details of which item you want to bid on
- 2. Details of what your maximum bid is
- 3. Money / or an agreement you'll pay them back if you win the bid on the night

(NB: The item will go to the next highest bidder if your proxy is unable to pay)

I'm acting as a proxy – what do I do?

If you're acting as a proxy for a friend or family member on the night please:

- 1. Write down their name with a (P) rather than your own name
- 2. Don't bid more than they are willing to spend
- 3. If your bid is successful, pay for the item and pass on the details you are given to the person you were a proxy for

- 1. Appoint a proxy to bid in your place. They will need the following:
 - o Details of which item you want to bid on
 - o Details of what your maximum bid is
 - Money / or an agreement you'll pay them back if you win the bid on the night
